Dr Mattie Hendrick, VMD, Dipl ACVP

Dr. Hendrick is a graduate of the University of Pennsylvania School of Veterinary Medicine. She completed a research Fellowship in pathology at Harvard Medical School, a portion of which was in a residency in pathology at the San Diego Zoo. She was an Assistant Professor of pathology at Tufts University School of Veterinary Medicine and a Professor of pathology at the University of Pennsylvania School of Veterinary Medicine. She is the co-author of the chapter on Tumors of The Skin and Soft Tissues, in "Tumors in domestic animals" (Ed. D.J. Meuten, 4th edition, 2002, Wiley-Blackwell) and she participated to the WHO histological classifications, volumes on the Epithelial and Melanocytic Tumors of the Skin Of Domestic Animals, and on the Mesenchymal Tumors of the Skin and Soft Tissues of Domestic Animals.

Dr Michael Goldschmidt, MSc, BVMS, MRCVS, Dipl ACVP

Dr Michael Goldschmidt received his DVM from the University of London, Royal Veterinary College. He is currently Head of surgical pathology and Professor of pathology at the Veterinary School of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. He is author and co-author of numerous publications, including, the chapter On Tumors Of The Skin and Soft Tissues, in "Tumors in domestic animals" (Ed. D.J. Meuten, 4th edition, 2002, Wiley-Blackwell) and the volume on Histologic Classification of the Epithelial and Melanocytic Tumors of the Skin of Domestic Animals, WHO histological classification. His research interests are dermatopathology and neoplasia in the dog and cat with emphasis on skin and soft tissue tumors, mammary dysplasia and neoplasia.
